The development of good relationships between home and school provides the opportunity to offer ongoing feedback regarding academic and behavioural progress, and particularly the ability to effectively problem solve in order to overcome any challenges that may arise.

As such, alongside more frequent phone conversations and text messages that form the essential day to day contact, we have developed a system of tutor reviews that are designed to offer up to date information regarding each pupil's academic achievement, wellbeing, behavioural progress and any other specific positive incidents, or concerns. It also provides an opportunity for parents to raise any issues they may have.

The tutor reviews take place once per term; however, it is important to note that if at any point you feel that you would like to speak to someone regarding a pupil, please do not hesitate to contact us and we will endeavour to get back to you as soon as possible.
